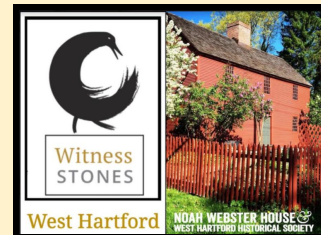

The project has placed 21 stones in the Old Center Cemetery - and there are at least 40 more people to commemorate.
