

**TERMINATION OF THE DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY
GLOBAL PANDEMIC OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE**

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, I, Shari G. Cantor, Mayor of the Town of West Hartford, acting pursuant to the powers provided in section 8 of chapter III of the Town Charter and section 28-8a of the General Statutes, declared that a state of emergency existed in the Town of West Hartford as a result of the global pandemic of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (“COVID-19”); and

WHEREAS, the number of infections, hospitalizations and deaths has been declining in the State of Connecticut and the Town due to the increased availability of COVID-19 vaccines; and


WHEREAS, on September 27, 2021, Governor Ned Lamont issued and renewed declarations of public health and civil preparedness emergencies through February 15, 2022, in accordance with the requirements of Special Act 21-5; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2021, the General Assembly approved by resolution the renewal of such emergency declarations; and

WHEREAS, under the public health and civil preparedness emergencies declared by the Governor, the Town Manager, as the chief executive officer of the Town, shall continue to have the power and authority necessary to meet the emergencies; and

WHEREAS, for reasons set forth above, a local emergency declaration is no longer necessary for the Town to address the health and welfare of the public or to coordinate federal, state and local authorities in response to the risks posed by COVID-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SHARI G. CANTOR, MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF WEST HARTFORD, HEREBY ORDER THAT the state of emergency I declared on March 15, 2020 shall terminate on October 21, 2021.
