As part of CTDOT's I-84 project in West Hartford, there will be an upcoming closure of Berkshire Road for thru traffic between Mildred Rd and New Britain Ave. Berkshire Road closure is anticipated from Friday May 13 through Friday May 20, 2022, see below for details:

Friday May 13, 2022 (if necessary) - Monday – May 16, 2022

• Lane closures Per Contract (Alternating Roadway Traffic - 9:00am to 3:00pm with Open Sidewalk)

Tuesday – May 17, 2022

- Lane closures Per Contract (Alternating Roadway Traffic 9:00am to 11:00am with Open Sidewalk)
- Close road and utilize detour once the single bus scheduled at 11:00am has passed.
- From 2:00pm to 4:00pm (Alternating Roadway Traffic 9:00am to 3:00pm with Open Sidewalk)
- From 4:00pm to maximum of 8:00pm detour will be utilized.

Wednesday – May 18, 2022

- Lane closures Per Contract (Alternating Roadway Traffic 9:00am to 11:00am with designated pedestrian passage).
- Close road and utilize detour at 11:00am.
- From 12:30pm to 2:45pm (Alternating Roadway Traffic with designated pedestrian passage)
- From 2:45pm to maximum of 8:00pm detour will be utilized.

Thursday – May 19, 2022

- Lane closures Per Contract (Alternating Roadway Traffic 9:00am to 11:00am with designated pedestrian passage).
- Close road and utilize detour once the single bus scheduled at 11:00am has passed.
- From 2:00pm to 4:00pm (Alternating Roadway Traffic with designated pedestrian passage).
- From 4:00pm to maximum of 8:00pm detour will be utilized.

Friday – May 20, 2022 – (If Necessary)

- Lane closures Per Contract (Alternating Roadway Traffic 9:00am to 11:00am with Open Sidewalk)
- Close road and utilize detour once the single bus scheduled at 11:00a has passed.
- From 2:00p to 4:00p (Alternating Roadway Traffic with Open Sidewalk or designated pedestrian passage)

The closure will take place on 5/13/22 to 5/20/22 (F-F) during the hours noted above. This closure is necessary to safely erect the steel beams for the new Berkshire Road bridges being constructed. A detour using Ridgewood Rd will be put in place each day.
